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Field-Linked Targets: Additional off-airfield targets are linked to fields. Sometimes their destruction is required to close the field. Generally their destruction will add to the rebuild time of all of the linked airfield country's structures. Fields and their linked targets are indicated in a chart like the example to the right.

Each field number is followed by a symbol and a location. The symbol describes the type of target. The location uses the three-digit "keypad reference" to denote it's position. Targets can be referred to as "Bridge 663" or "Refinery 772".
